Architectural Paint Analysis Techniques Derived from Analysis of Art Objects

- Visible and ultraviolet light reflected cross-section microscopy with binder characterization using fluorochrome stains
- Transmitted polarized light microscopy for fibers and pigments




Sample Casting and Processing

- Small samples (as small as a pinhead) cast in polyester resin cubes and polished to expose the cross-section stratigraphies
- Dispersed samples scraped from individual layers and cast onto microscope slides for polarized light microscopy of pigments and fibers

Center Passage Red-brown Paint Pigments Red ochre, burnt sienna, haematite, CaCO₃ Plane polarized transmitted light 1000X








Sample 103-12. Synthetic Ultramarine In Blue Distemper



































Color measurement and matching conducted with the help of a colorimeter/microscope. Matches made in the Munsell and CIE L*a*b* color spaces.

Further Paint Investigation Work at The Cupola House

- •Further analysis of plaster fragments
- •Re-sample second-floor ceiling medallion
- •Selective overpaint removal to reveal ceiling medallion carvings
- •Refine understanding of baseboard and door paints
- •Refine color matching for original first-floor woodwork paints
- •Resolve color interpretation for the rear first-floor rooms
- •Discuss woodwork preparation prior to repainting
- •Discuss paint replication approaches and materials
